To our loyal Patrons, Volunteers and Community,

At Spokane Civic Theatre, we continue to monitor and respond to the COVID-19 outbreak impacting our community and world.

Following Governor Inslee's statewide emergency proclamation temporarily shutting down restaurants, bars and entertainment venues, it is with a heavy heart that we will be rescheduling all current programming including Main Stage and Studio Theatre productions, *Funny Girl* auditions and Academy classes at least through March 31. *Cabaret*, *The Humans*, *Exile*, and *Funny Girl* will be postponed and rescheduled. Regarding new performance dates, like you, we are waiting on further guidance from Governor Inslee and the CDC. While new dates have not yet been confirmed, they will be communicated as quickly as possible. At this time, we ask that you keep your ticket(s) as they will be transferable to new dates.


In an effort to be good community stewards, Spokane Civic Theatre employees will be doing their part to help keep all members of our community safe by practicing social distancing and working from various locations.
