Back Stage Costume Crew responsibility

- Read the Script
- Attend the designer run
- Prepare and maintain a clean change area
- Rehearse quick changes
- Work during dress rehearsals and performance dates
- Check in with stage manager
- Introduce yourself to the cast
- Be Flexible and cheerful

Rental Assistant

- Customer service assisting the public
- Repairs and maintenance of stock
- Organizing stock as directed

Wig maintained by assistant

- Read the script
- Attend the designer run
- Keep the wigs styled as directed during the show run, Wed. and Fri.
- Present during tech week as requested

Costume Shop Assistance

- Hand stitching- buttons, closures, hems, trims as needed
- Help needed usually 2 weeks before the show opens
- Machine stitching- serging, some building
